
AGM offers a rich variety of co-curricular classes to enhance the learning experience including physical education, Armenian dance and music classes, art, and instrumental orchestra.

Common Core Standards

The Common Core standards guide AGM curriculum. The Common Core standards are a set of educational benchmarks that outline what students should know and be able to do at each grade level in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics from kindergarten through 12th grade. The standards focus on developing critical thinking, problemsolving, and analytical skills to ensure our students are well-prepared for their years beyond AGM.

**The state has adopted lists of recommended curriculum materials for grades K-8 in math and English language arts, which includes McGraw-Hill Wonders for ELA and Savvas Envision for Math.





Savvas Envision (2022)

AGM adopted enVision Math in 2022. It aligns with Common Core standards, ensuring comprehensive coverage of essential mathematical concepts. The curriculum spans from basic arithmetic to advanced topics, preparing students for higher-level math. It emphasizes understanding the 'why' behind mathematical procedures, promoting deeper comprehension. It encourages students to explain their reasoning, fostering deeper understanding.

Science

McGraw-Hill Inspire (2019)

In 2019, AGM adopted McGraw-Hill Inspire Science built with the instructional framework that provides an in-depth, collaborative, evidence-based, and project-based learning experience. It aligns with Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) and other state standards, ensuring comprehensive coverage of essential scientific concepts. Tailored content for each grade level provides a seamless progression of scientific understanding. The curriculum promotes active learning through hands-on experiments and investigations, helping students to develop a deeper understanding of scientific principles. It encourages students to ask questions, make observations, and conduct experiments, fostering critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

McGraw-Hill Wonders (2020)

Since 2020, AGM has been using the McGraw-Hill Wonders English Language Arts program. McGraw Hill Wonders comprehensive literacy program aligns with the Common Core State Standards (CCSS). The curriculum focuses on key areas such as reading, writing, speaking, and listening, ensuring that students develop the skills necessary to succeed academically. The materials include a variety of texts, activities, and assessments that are specifically designed to support the Common Core's goals of preparing students for college and career readiness. Students are encouraged to find and use text-based evidence in their responses, promoting critical thinking and analytical skills. The program includes questioning strategies that develop higher-order thinking skills.

Structured phonics instruction helps build foundational reading skills, especially for early learners. The program emphasizes vocabulary acquisition, critical for reading comprehension and overall literacy development.

In addition to utilizing the Wonders program, upper elementary ELA teachers incorporate novel studies throughout the year. Novel studies allow for deep exploration of themes, characters, and plots, helping students develop advanced reading comprehension skills. Students analyze complex texts which helps promote critical thinking. Novel studies help foster a lifelong love for reading in our AGM Eagles.

Wordly Wise Vocabulary

To further enhance vocabulary acquisition, AGM utilizes the Wordly Wise Vocabulary program in 2nd-6th grades, a supplemental program designed to improve students' vocabulary, reading comprehension, and overall language skills. Each grade level has carefully selected vocabulary lists that are appropriate for students' reading and comprehension abilities. Vocabulary words become progressively more challenging as students advance through the program.

Social Studies

McGraw-Hill Impact (2022)

In 2022, the school adopted McGraw-Hill Impact Social Studies curriculum designed around the National Council for the Social Studies (NCSS) standards to provide a framework for teaching, learning, and assessing social studies in schools. The standards focus on ten themes, which include topics such as culture, time, continuity, and change, people, places, and environments, individual development and identity, and civic ideals and practices. These themes aim to ensure that students develop the knowledge, skills, and attitudes necessary to become informed and engaged citizens in a diverse and interdependent world.

Each unit provides active engagement with a rich variety of informational texts, primary sources, and media. In a developmental approach across grade levels, students use disciplinary tools and strategies to think like a historian, a geographer, an economist, and as
