## A PAGE FROM THE RECIPE BOOK ORT. TALIN'S CHOREG

2 tablespoons yeast  
1/4 cup of warm water  
1/2 teaspoon sugar  
6 cups flour  
1 cup sugar  
1/4 tablespoon mahlab  
1/4 teaspoon mastic  
5 eggs (1 egg to brush on top)  
1 cup milk (lukewarm)  
1 cup unsalted butter (melted)

1. Mix the yeast with warm water and 1/2 teaspoon sugar. Set aside for 15-20 minutes until it rises.
  2. Mix the dry ingredients and set aside
  3. Mix the wet ingredients, then combine with the dry ingredients.
  4. Mix in the yeast and set aside in a warm place for 4 hours to let it rise.  
(Pro tip: place in the oven with the light turned on, but do not bake!)
  5. Once risen, split into three balls and roll out into long pieces. Braid the pieces, brush 1 egg on top and sprinkle sesame seeds
  6. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. It should look nicely golden brown.

3rd grade shows off their science project testing whether a seedling will grow with something other than water.



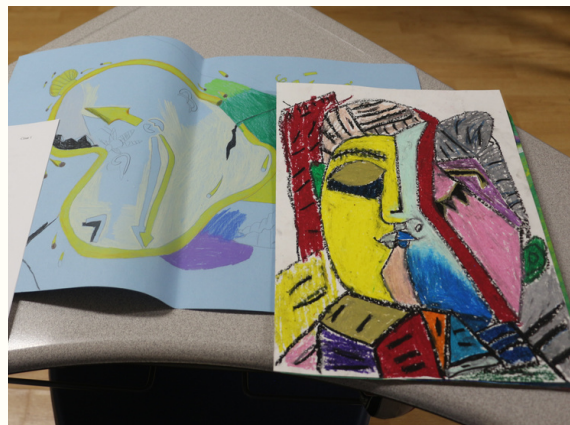
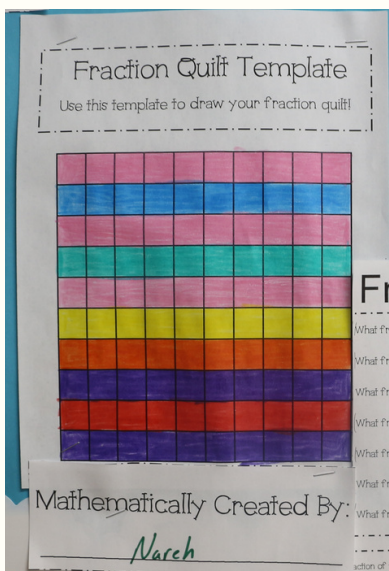
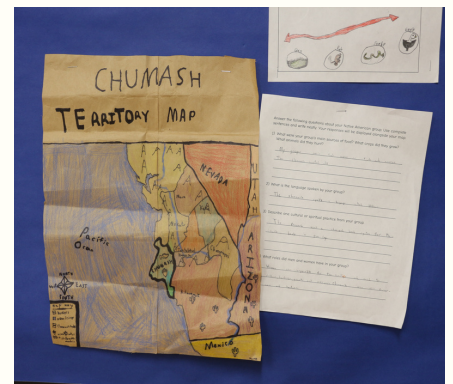
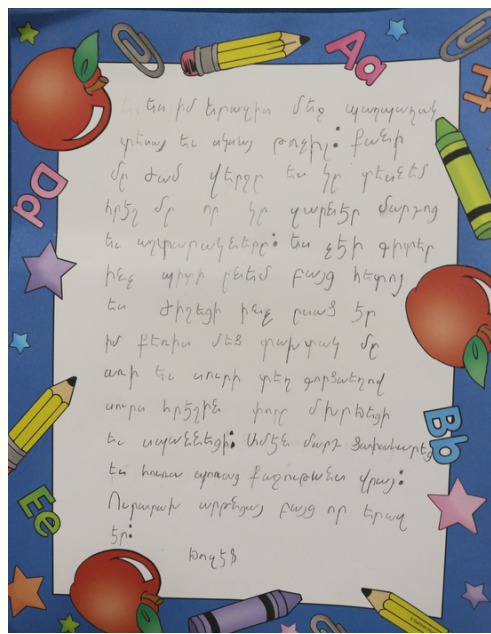
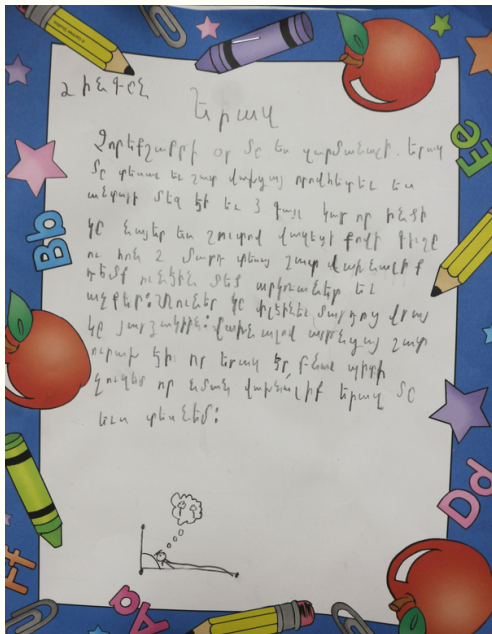

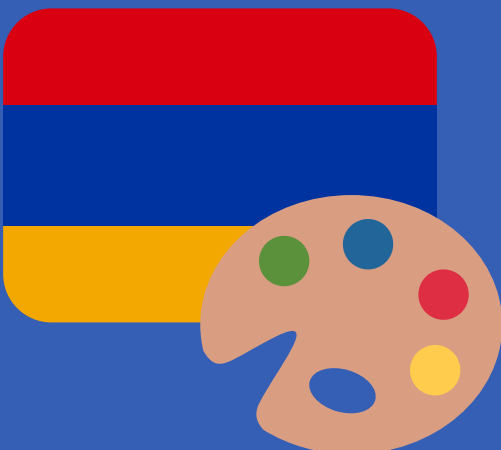


AGM Preschool is growing!
